



11 Days Eastern China-Spring Tour (18th-28th.April)

Day 1 : 18th. April

Arrival into Shanghai, Birding at Nanhui

Day 2 : 19th. April

Nanhui to Rudong, Birding in Rudong

rive to Rudong, mainly to look for the rare Spoon-billed Sandpiper, and Nordmann's Greenshank, Chinese Egret(Swinhoe's). the other speices include Red-necked Stints, Red Knot,Sanderling, Sharp-tailed Sandpiper, Dunlin, Curlew Sandpiper , Broad-billed Sandpiper, Great Knot, Kentish Plovers, Mongolian and Greater Sandplovers, Terek Sandpiper and Grey-tailed Tattler, Grey Plover, Pacific Golden Plovers, Common Greenshank, Common Redshank,Bar-tailed Godwit, Eurasian Whimbrel, Eurasian Curlew, long-billed ,Far Eastern Curlew,Eurasian Oystercatcher ,Black-winged Stilt, Pied Avocet, Common Sandpiper, Spotted Redshank, Marsh, Wood and Green Sandpipers and Eastern Black-tailed Godwit, Long-toed Stints, Saunders's Gulls, Black-tailed, Mongolian and Heuglin's Gulls, Grey-headed Lapwing, Oriental Pratincole,Pheasant-tailed Jacana, Little Curlew is also possible if we are lucky enough. We will also search around the forested areas and woods, farmlands, this may yields us Forest Wagtail, Pechora Pipit, Siberian Thrush, Eye-browed,Grey-backed Thrush, White's Thrush, Japanese Thrush, Chinese Blackbird, Siberian Rubythroat, Rufous-tailed and Siberian Blue Robins, Manchurian Bush-Warbler, Chinese Grosbeak, Black-faced, Little, Yellow-breasted, Yellow-browed , Chestnut, Tristram's Buntings, Bull-headed Shrike, Japanese Paradise-Flycatcher. Night in Jianggang Town.

Day 3 : 20th. April

Birding at Tiao zi ni Area

Tiao zi ni has the best muddy flats , which are good for shorebirds, we mainly go there to look for the rare Spoon-billed Sandpiper, and Nordmann's Greenshank, Chinese Egret(Swinhoe's). the other speices include Red-necked Stints, Red Knot, Sanderling, Sharp-tailed Sandpiper, Dunlin, Curlew Sandpiper , Broad-billed Sandpiper, Great Knot, Kentish Plovers, Mongolian and Greater Sandplovers, Terek Sandpiper and Grey-tailed Tattler, Grey Plover, Pacific Golden Plovers, Common Greenshank, Common Redshank, Bar-tailed Godwit, Eurasian Whimbrel, Eurasian Curlew, long-billed ,Far Eastern Curlew,Eurasian Oystercatcher ,Black-winged Stilt, Pied Avocet, Common Sandpiper, Spotted Redshank, Marsh, Wood and Green Sandpipers and Eastern Black-tailed Godwit, Long-toed Stints, Saunders's Gulls, Black-tailed, Mongolian and Heuglin's Gulls, Grey-headed Lapwing, Oriental



Pratincole, Pheasant-tailed Jacana, Little Curlew is also possible if we are lucky enough. We will also search around the forested areas and woods, grasslands, farmlands, this may yields us Forest Wagtail, Pechora Pipit, Siberian Thrush, Eye-browed, Grey-backed Thrush, White ' s Thrush, Japanese Thrush, Chinese Blackbird, Siberian Rubythroat, Rufous-tailed and Siberian Blue Robins, Manchurian Bush-Warbler, Chinese Grosbeak, Black-faced, Little, Yellow-breasted, Yellow-browed , Chestnut, Tristram ' s Buntings, Bull-headed Shrike, Japanese Paradise-Flycatcher. Night in Jianggang Town.

Day 4 : 21st. April

Tiao zi ni to Shanghai to Wuyuan

Birding in the morning, then we drive back to Shanghai Hongqiao Railway Station, take the high-speed Train to Wuyuan, Night in Wuyuan.

Day 5 : 22nd. April

Birding in Wuyuan

Wuyuan is a very beautiful country area in Jiangxi province, the forest coverage here reached to 85 %, and it is home to 370 bird species, There are many ancient villages scattered around the area, some rare birds have also found their home in the trees nearby the villages, the Courtois ' s Laughingthrush(Blue-crowned Laughingthrush in Chinese)is the rarest in the area, the total number of this species is estimated only around 200. We will spend some time with them on a small island near a village. another good bird we could see here is Pied Falconet, they are widely spread the whole south China, but not easy to see in some other places. they other birds we are here to look for include Mandarin Duck, Chinese Bamboo-Partridge, Black Baza, Chinese Sparrowhawk, Long-billed Plover, Large Hawk-cuckoo, Indian Cuckoo, Crested Kingfisher, Grey-capped Pygmy Woodpecker, White-throated Needletail, Swinhoe ' s and Grey-chinned Minivets, Brown-breasted, Chinese and Chestnut Bulbuls, Dollarbird, Black-winged Cuckooshrike, Dusky and Grey-cheeked Fulvettas, Collared Finchbill, White-crowned Forktail, Chinese Hwamei, White-browed, Masked and Moustached Laughingthrushes, Rufous-faced Warbler, Black-throated Bushtit, Short-tailed Parrotbill, Grey Treepie, Black-collared and Red-billed Starlings. Night in Wuyuan.

Day 6 : 23rd. April

Birding in Wuyuan



Another day birding in Wuyuan. Looking for species we might still miss. Mandarin Duck, Chinese Bamboo-Partridge, Black Baza, Chinese Sparrowhawk, Long-billed Plover, Large Hawk-cuckoo, Indian Cuckoo, Crested Kingfisher, Grey-capped Pygmy Woodpecker, White-throated Needletail, Swinhoe 's and Grey-chinned Minivets, Brown-breasted, Chinese and Chestnut Bulbuls, Dollarbird, Black-winged Cuckooshrike, Dusky and Grey-cheeked Fulvettas, Collared Finchbill, White-crowned Forktail, Chinese Hwamei, White-browed, Masked and Moustached Laughingthrushes, Rufous-faced Warbler, Black-throated Bushtit, Short-tailed Parrotbill, Grey Treepie, Black-collared and Red-billed Starlings. Night in Wuyuan.

Day 7 : 24th. April

Wuyuan to Emeifeng in Fujian Province

After some early morning time in Wuyuan, we will move on for a 6 hours drive to Emeifeng, if our time is still ok, we will be in search of the Elliot's Pheasant for the rest of the afternoon. Night at Emeifeng.

Day 8 : 25th. April

Birding at Emeifeng

Mainly to look for Cabot's Tragopan, Elliot's Pheasant, Koklass Pheasant, Silver Pheasants, White-necklaced and Chinese Bamboo Partridges. Other species include Buffy Laughingthrush, Mustached Laughingthrush, Indo-Chinese, Black-chinned Yuhinas, Chestnut Bulbul, Rufous-faced Warbler, Kloss 's Leaf Warbler, White-spectacled Warbler, Small Niltava, Spotted Elachura, Blyth 's Shrike-Babbler, Huet 's Fulvetta, Buff-throated Warbler and Brown Bush Warbler, Barred Cuckoo-Dove, Large Hawk-Cuckoo, Lesser Cuckoos, Collared Owlet, Bay Woodpecker, Great Barbet. Grey-chinned Minivet, White-bellied Erpornis, Yellow-cheeked, Sultan Tit, Black-throated Bushtit, Brown-flanked Bush Warbler, Sulphur-breasted Warbler, Chestnut-crowned Warbler, Mountain and Himalayan Black Bulbuls, Streak-breasted Scimitar-Babbler, Pygmy Wren-Babbler, Rufous-capped Babbler, Red-billed Leiothrix, Chestnut-bellied Rock-Thrush, Blue Whistling-Thrush, Little, Spotted, Slaty-backed and White-crowned Forktails, Orange-bellied Leafbird, the rare Brown-chested Jungle Flycatcher, Grey-headed Parrotbill. Day 9 : 26th. April

Birding at Emeifeng



Another day birding at Emeifeng, Looking for the species that we might still missing. Cabot's Tragopan, Elliot's Pheasant, Koklass Pheasant, Silver Pheasants, White-necklaced and Chinese Bamboo Partridges. other species include Buffy Laughingthrush, Mustached Laughingthrush, Indo-Chinese, Black-chinned Yuhinas, Chestnut Bulbul, Rufous-faced Warbler, Kloss' s Leaf Warbler, White-spectacled Warbler, Small Niltava, Spotted Elachura, Blyth' s Shrike-Babbler, Huet' s Fulvetta, Buff-throated Warbler and Brown Bush Warbler, Barred Cuckoo-Dove, Large Hawk-Cuckoo, Lesser Cuckoos, Collared Owlet, Bay Woodpecker, Great Barbet. Grey-chinned Minivet, White-bellied Erpornis, Yellow-cheeked, Sultan Tit, Black-throated Bushtit, Brown-flanked Bush Warbler, Sulphur-breasted Warbler, Chestnut-crowned Warbler, Mountain and Himalayan Black Bulbuls, Streak-breasted Scimitar-Babbler, Pygmy Wren-Babbler, Rufous-capped Babbler, Red-billed Leiothrix, Chestnut-bellied Rock-Thrush, Blue Whistling-Thrush, Little, Spotted, Slaty-backed and White-crowned Forktails, Orange-bellied Leafbird, the rare Brown-chested Jungle Flycatcher, Grey-headed Parrotbill.

Day 10 : 27th. April

Emeifeng to Nanchang

We spend half day in Emeifeng to look for the birds we might still missing, then drive 4.5 hours to Nanchang, Over night in Nanchang.

Day 11 : 28th. April
